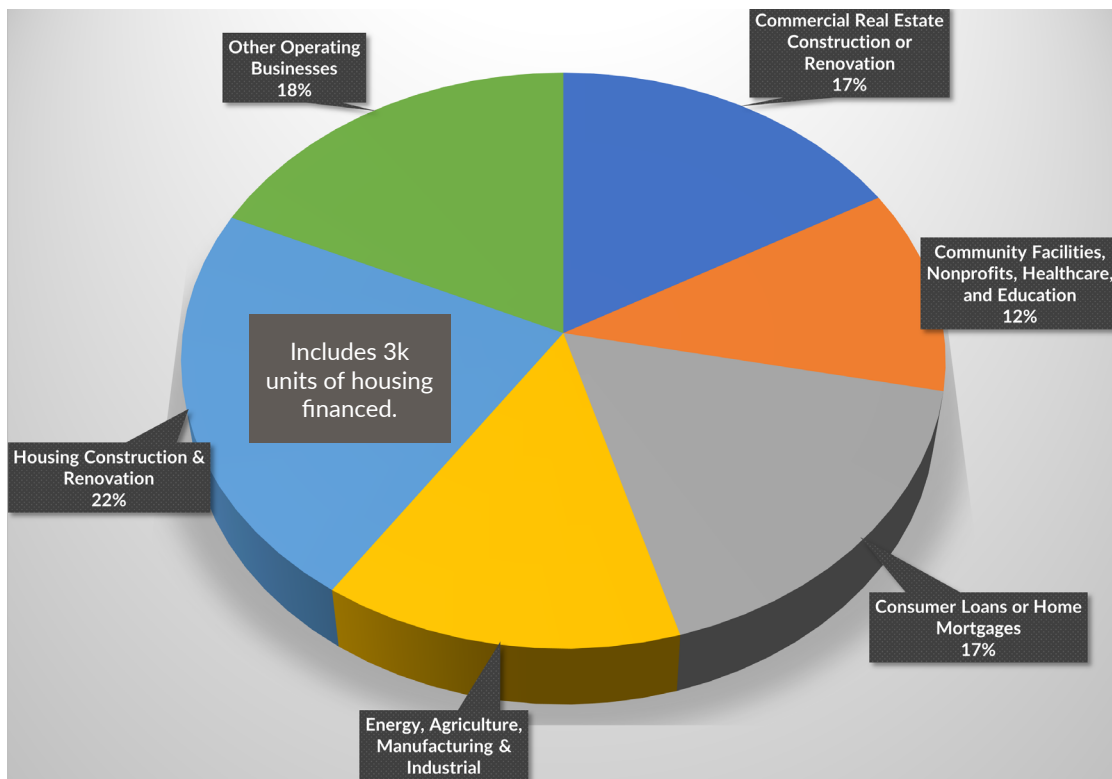


Of that activity, 2.5k loans and investments totaling \$352M went to Georgia businesses, nonprofits, and community facilities, with the balance going to individuals and families.

OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES

- There were 29 certified CDFIs headquartered in Georgia as of February 2023, including 13 loan funds, 6 credit unions, and 10 CDFI banks..
- Through February 2023, the CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$1.7B in financial assistance, bond authority, and tax credit allocation to Georgia-headquartered CDFIs and CDEs.
