

GAUDENZIA, INC. ADDICTION TREATMENT & RECOVERY CENTER CLAYMONT, DELAWARE

The recent opioid crisis hit Delaware harder than most states, and has driven social service organizations to find new ways to support men, women, and families recovering from addiction.

To address this problem, Gaudenzia is redeveloping a 23,600 square feet vacant office building into transitional housing for individuals recovering from addiction.

The center will house a sixteen-bed residential treatment program for women and men with severe and persistent mental illness affected by drug or alcohol addiction. It will also contain ten apartments for newly-sober single women in recovery, with space for their children under the age of ten to live with them. These transitional apartments and treatment programs allow participants to get back on their feet and on their way to healthier and happier lives for themselves and their families.

For the last 50 years, Gaudenzia has served 17,000 individuals annually through 161 drug and alcohol treatment programs at 90 facilities in Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, and Washington, D.C.
