TOTAL INVESTMENT



36.1k originations totaling \$1.9 billion

JOBS



35.1k permanent FTE jobs 5k construction jobs

BUSINESS INVESTMENT



Of that activity, 32.3k loans and investments totaling \$336.3 million went to Illinois businesses, nonprofits, and community facilities, with the balance going to individuals and families.

REAL ESTATE



2.1 million sq. ft. of commerical real estate constructed or rehabilitated

CONSUMER LOANS



793 consumer loans totaling \$631.2k

MANUFACTURING



50 loans and investments totaling \$47.4 million to manufacturing and industrial businesses

HOUSING



763 home purchase and improvement loans totaling \$526.8 million, including \$169.7 million to 766 first-time homeowners



1.9k affordable housing units financed

OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES (AS OF FEBRUARY 2025)

- There are 36 certified CDFIs headquartered in Illinois, including 8 banks, 16 credit unions, 10 loan funds, and 2 venture capital funds.
- There are 87 CDFI branches in Illinois.
- The CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$335.7 million in financial assistance to Illinois-headquartered CDFIs along with \$4 billion in NMTC allocation and CDFI Bond awards to CDFIs and CDEs headquartered in Illinois.
