#### **TOTAL INVESTMENT**



14.7k originations totaling \$1.9 billion

#### **JOBS**



6.7k permanent FTE jobs 4.1k construction jobs

#### **BUSINESS INVESTMENT**



Of that activity, 3.3k loans and investments totaling \$337.1 million went to lowa businesses, nonprofits, and community facilities, with the balance going to individuals and families.

#### **REAL ESTATE**



2.1 million sq. ft. of commerical real estate constructed or rehabilitated

#### **CONSUMER LOANS**



791 consumer loans totaling \$6.7k

#### **MANUFACTURING**



26 loans and investments totaling \$75.5 million to manufacturing and industrial businesses

#### **HOUSING**



5.1k home purchase and improvement loans totaling \$1.2 billion, including \$20.2 million to 231 first-time homeowners

#### **OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES (AS OF FEBRUARY 2025)**

- There are 9 certified CDFIs headquartered in lowa, including 5 credit unions, 4 loan funds.
- There are 86 CDFI branches in Iowa.
- The CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$34.1 million in financial assistance to lowaheadquartered CDFIs along with \$1.8 billion in NMTC allocation and CDFI Bond awards to CDFIs and CDEs headquartered in lowa.
