TOTAL INVESTMENT



15.5k originations totaling \$741.1 million

JOBS



12.3k permanent FTE jobs 3.1k construction jobs

BUSINESS INVESTMENT



Of that activity, 12.5k loans and investments totaling \$76.5 million went to Massachusetts businesses, nonprofits, and community facilities, with the balance going to individuals and families.

REAL ESTATE



1.5 million sq. ft. of commerical real estate constructed or rehabilitated

CONSUMER LOANS



367 consumer loans totaling \$5 million

HOUSING



461 home purchase and improvement loans totaling \$355.8 million, including \$72.2 million to 324 first-time homeowners



591 affordable housing units financed

OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES (AS OF FEBRUARY 2025)

- There are 31 certified CDFIs headquartered in Massachusetts, including 1 bank, 2 credit unions, 27 loan funds, and 1 venture capital fund.
- There are 61 CDFI branches in Massachusetts.
- The CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$403 million in financial assistance to Massachusettsheadquartered CDFIs along with \$3.1 billion in NMTC allocation and CDFI Bond awards to CDFIs and CDEs headquartered in Massachusetts.
