- There are 37 certified CDFIs headquartered in Ohio, including 1 bank, 21 credit unions, 14 loan funds, and 1 venture capital fund.
- There are 149 CDFI branches in Ohio.
- The CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$264.5 million in financial assistance to Ohioheadquartered CDFIs along with \$3.8 billion in NMTC allocation and CDFI Bond awards to CDFIs and CDEs headquartered in Ohio.
