## TOTAL INVESTMENT



6.1k originations totaling \$692.8 million

## JOBS



3k permanent FTE jobs  
4.3k construction jobs

## BUSINESS INVESTMENT



Of that activity, 3.3k loans and investments totaling \$41.5 million went to Oklahoma businesses, nonprofits, and community facilities, with the balance going to individuals and families.

## REAL ESTATE



79.2 million sq. ft. of commercial real estate constructed or rehabilitated

## CONSUMER LOANS



208 consumer loans totaling \$3.4 million

## MANUFACTURING



164 loans and investments totaling \$18.6 million to manufacturing and industrial businesses

## HOUSING



1.7k home purchase and improvement loans totaling \$142.5 million, including \$22.8 million to 116 first-time homeowners



1.1k affordable housing units financed

## OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES (AS OF FEBRUARY 2025)

- There are 16 certified CDFIs headquartered in Oklahoma, including 5 banks, 4 credit unions, 6 loan funds, and 1 venture capital fund.
- There are 38 CDFI branches in Oklahoma.
- There are also 7 Native CDFIs in Oklahoma.
- The CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$88.5 million in financial assistance to Oklahoma-headquartered CDFIs along with \$1.3 billion in NMTC allocation and CDFI Bond awards to CDFIs and CDEs headquartered in Oklahoma.
