Legislative Update

Where we are today

- **Key Dates**
 - January 30th – Current CR Expires
 - This week- Senate Appropriations Bills
 - HR 7006- FSGG, National Security & State Department
 - HR 7148- Labor & HHS, Homeland Security, Transportation, HUD, DOD
- **HR 7006**
 - No clear controversies, likely to pass
 - Received over 300 votes in the House
 - Unclear on exact date it will be considered on the Senate Floor, no later than the 30th
- **OMB Staffing Update**
 - Mark Calabria being replaced by Clark Abourisk
 - Abourisk previously Counsel at House Oversight Committee

Key Provisions- HR 7006

- **\$324 Million for the CDFI Fund**
- **Limits total loan principal for Bond Guarantee program to \$500 million**
- **NMTC- Encourages focus on areas in Appalachia affected by flooding in 2022 & 2025**
- **Persistent Poverty- Report from the Fund, Priority on additional funds to CDFIs that provided no less than 15% of total lending to persistent poverty counties**

Economic Mobility Corps	\$2 million
Native Initiatives	\$28 million
Bank Enterprise Award Program	\$40 million
Healthy Food Financing Initiative	\$24 million
Small Dollar Loan Program	\$9 million
Administrative Expenses	\$35 million
Total, CDFI Fund Program Account	\$324 million

What's Next?

- When the FSGG Bill passes- Key time to continue advocacy/outreach
- Upcoming:
 - House Financial Services Committee Hearing February 4th with Secretary Bessent
 - Outreach to encourage members of the committee to bring up CDFI Funding Issues to Treasury Officials
 - Main outreach should be targeted at members of the committee who also signed a 2025 CDFI support letter (See next slide)
- Outreach to Appropriations Committee
- New Fact sheet to come
 - Focus on CDFIs playing a key role in housing as this is an Administration priority
